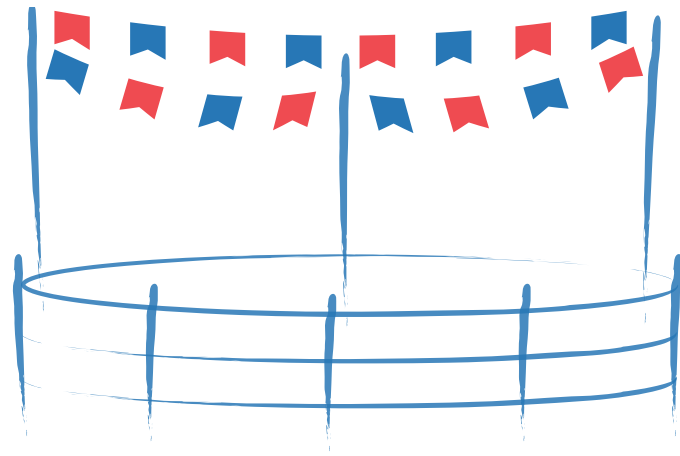


*- Dungog Showground Map -*
